The above chart reflects the class averages and the final cell on the right contains the combined average for Kindergarten through 9th grades.

The Basic Battery includes the core subjects only.

The Average indicate the relative stand of a class in comparison with National (National Individual) classes in the same grade in the norm (reference) group who took the test at a comparable time.

10, 20, and 30's are below average.

40, 50, and 60's are average.

70, 80, and 90's are above average.

These scores reflect an increase over last year's scores in the following subjects:

Vocabulary (2 points higher)

Math (1 point higher)

Spelling (4 points higher!)

Language (4 points higher!)

Science (5 points higher!)

Thinking Skills (2 points higher)

Plus, the over all ECCS scores for the Basic Battery and the Complete Battery increase by two points. This is the first year we have averaged 80 and above in ALL subjects tested! This is a great achievement and one that we can all be proud of! ECCS has a strong academic standing in the community, state, and nation.
